Catalog Of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA)

Financial and non-financial assistance programs administered by departments and establishments of the Federal government.

Congressional Research Service (CRS)

The Congressional Research Service offers key internet grant information including CRS publications on federal funding programs.

Weekly Federal Funding Report

Weekly compilation of items published in the Federal Register which affect Federal Domestic Assistance Programs.

The Federal Register

Provides a uniform system for making public regulations and legal notices issued by Federal agencies available to the public. The Federal Register is also available at most education and public libraries.

Today's Federal Register And Archives (Grantsmanship Center)

Today's Federal Register, gives current day's grants announcements, department and agency announcements of grant application review meetings, grant awards, deadlines, requests for comments on agency procedures, new rule reminders, and special events. The Federal Register Archives section includes grant announcements going back one year: search by keyword/subject "AND 2001" for notices updating the latest Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance.
